EVERY STUDENT HAS THE RIGHT TO OPINION. EDUCATORS TEACH THEIR STUDENTS ABOUT THE CANADIAN CHARTER OF RIGHTS AND FREEDOMS IN GRADE 5 SOCIAL STUDIES. THUS, STUDENTS UNDERSTAND THAT THEY HAVE THE RIGHT TO OPINION AND EXPRESSION.

HOWEVER, EDUCATORS MUST TEACH
THEIR STUDENTS ABOUT THE LIMITS
OF THESE RIGHTS AND TO WHAT
EXTENT THESE RIGHTS CAN BE
USED. MEDIA IS AN EXCELLENT
FORM TO 'RESIST' STEREOTYPES
OR DISCRIMINATION BUT, ONLY
WHEN USED IN A PROPER MANNER
AND AS EDUCATORS WE MUST
TEACH OUR STUDENTS TO USE A
RESPECTFUL FORM OF
EXPRESSION.

BY OBSERVING STUDENTS IN THE FORMS OF POPULAR
CULTURE THEY INDULGE IN AS WELL AS, THEIR
CHARACTERISTICS, EDUCATORS ARE BETTER ABLE TO
ENGAGE STUDENTS IN ADVANCED LITERACY AND THUS,
STUDENTS WILL BE ABLE TO UNDERSTAND THESE FORMS
OF TEXTS BETTER.
